1. Strong Communities & Connected Residents

CDA Lokaal Veldhoven wants an inclusive municipality where everyone can participate. Neighborhoods are central, with support for local initiatives, community buildings, and stronger integration so newcomers become true neighbors.

2. Healthy Living & Caring Together

Health is viewed broadly, including personal well-being, a clean environment, and accessible care. The party wants more coordination between care organizations, a focus on prevention, and support for youth and elderly.

3. Housing & Spatial Planning

Everyone deserves a home. Veldhoven must continue building at least 400 homes per year, with a mix of social, affordable, and regular housing. Flexible housing solutions and senior relocation are encouraged.

4. Strong Associations for Everyone

Associations are vital for social cohesion. The municipality should support them with knowledge, shared services, simplified rules, and financial tools.

5. Mobility & Accessibility

The party wants better cycling, walking, and public transport. The HOV line is key, and the Citycentrum should get an HOV station.

6. Lifelong Learning & Equal Opportunities

Education is crucial. The party wants to reduce inequality, support newcomers with language education, and ensure enough school buildings.

7. Entrepreneurship & Local Economy

Growth brings challenges. The party wants to support SMEs, maintain vibrant village centers, and ensure enough business space.
